The Conference proceedings and collection of abstracts will be composed based on the Conference presentations. After revision materials and abstracts will be published in electronic form, submitted to the repository of the university and to the database of the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI).

Travel and accommodation expenses shall be covered by participants.

Formatting requirements for materials and abstracts:

- Abstracts should not be longer than 1 page. Maximum volume of articles is 3 pages.
- Font style and size: TimesNewRoman, 12 pt (pages are not numbered), single line-spacing. Page size: 297 × 210 mm (A4), Margins: top - 20 mm, left and bottom - 25 mm, right - 10 mm
- UDC is placed in the top-left corner The title is typed in capital letters. Authors' initials, names, academic rank and title, and full name of the institution (organization) in which the authors work shall be place below the title. The main text starts as a new paragraph (with indent).
- Formulas are typed in MicrosoftEguation 3.0, (MS Office App), Formula style: TimesNewRoman, 12pt, in bold italics. The line spacing before the formula line is 6–10 pt.
- Illustrations shall be inserted into the text where they are mentioned first. Each illustration shall have a caption (TimesNewRoman, 11 pt). Charts and diagrams are presented as images, made in an Image Editor app compatible with MS Word. Font style and size for coordinate axes names and dimensions: TimesNewRoman, 9–11 pt. Photos are formatted as black and white images in high contrast. Photos shall be submitted in raster graphics formats JPG, Tiff, BMP, PCX with a resolution of at least 300 dpi (additionally attached as separate files).

- Files are named after the author's name.
- Papers shall be signed by the author on the reverse side of the sheet. Articles and abstracts prepared by Master's students, postgraduate students and undergraduates shall be reviewed by the supervisor and signed accordingly.
- Articles and abstracts are included in the proceedings in the author's version after the presentation and the selection process. Materials not included in the collection shall not be returned to the authors.
